Code of Ethics Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement

Conflict of Interest – When a responsible person’s activities interfere with, influence, or may be perceived to interfere with or influence their ability to be impartial and make decisions in the best interest of the USATF. (*Responsible Person is any person serving as a Board member, officer, employee, independent contractor, volunteers who are a member of a committee, sub-committee, council, task force, hearing panel, or any other decision-making body of USATF, and includes any candidate for Board, committee, sub-committee, council, task force, hearing panel or any other decision-making body of USATF*).

Actual Conflict of Interest – When a responsible person has an active relationship with a person or organization that may influence his or her decision-making in his or her affiliation with USATF.

Potential Conflict of Interest – When an actual conflict of interest has not yet been established, there is reasonable cause to believe that a future event may create a conflict of interest.

Perceived Conflict of Interest – When a responsible person does not have an active relationship with a person or organization, but it may appear to another individual that a connection between the two exists and could influence decisions made by the responsible person. Also, when a responsible person has disclosed a conflict of interest and has recused themselves from decision making but takes actions that make it appear that they were involved in the decision.

Family member – Includes a spouse, child, stepchild, grandchild, parent, stepparent, grandparent, sibling, stepsibling, aunt, uncle, or first cousin, or any person living in the same household as the responsible person, and any of their spouses.

Sponsor & Vendor List – The USATF List of Sponsors, Vendors and Event Organizers is attached for reference. The list is not exhaustive and is subject to change. When assessing whether the responsible person’s situation fits into one of the above referenced categories of “conflict of interest,” an evaluation must be made regarding the responsible person’s direct or indirect interests (financial or otherwise) with organization(s) which USATF is dealing or considering dealing.
